- All articles are subject to peer review, and must adhere to the ICMJE (www.icmje.com), GPP-3 (www.ismpp.com/gpp3) and COPE (http://publicationethics.org/files/Code_of_conduct_for_journal_editors.pdf) guidelines.

Structure and Format

- *US Neurology* is a peer reviewed, free-to-access, bi-annual journal comprising review articles, case reports, editorials, special reports, and original research.
- The structure of each edition of the publication comprises section categories determined by the Managing Editor. The degree of coverage assigned to each category is the decision of the Managing Editor and, in part, reflects the views of the Editorial Board.
- All articles disclose any author disclosures along with any funding, financial support, and medical writing assistance.

Editorial Expertise

US Neurology is supported by various levels of expertise:

Peer Review

- On submission, all articles are assessed by the Managing Editor to determine their suitability for inclusion and appropriateness for peer review.
- The Editor identifies at least two appropriate reviewers, who are selected on the basis of their specialist knowledge in the relevant area, following consultation with a member of the Editorial Board where necessary.
- We aim to have the final peer review decision within 4 weeks.
- Following review, papers are either accepted without modification, returned to the author(s) to incorporate required changes or not accepted for publication.
- The Editor reserves the right to accept or reject any proposed amendments on the advice of the Editorial Board and reviewers.

Submissions and Instructions for Authors

- The Editor commissions articles with guidance from the Editorial Board and unsolicited articles are welcomed.
- The Editor is always keen to hear from authors wishing to discuss potential submissions, and will give due consideration to any proposals.
